



# KNOW AND PLAN AHEAD

## HOW, WHEN, AND WHERE YOU WILL VOTE.

- **Vote early by mail:** You can learn how to request a ballot-by-mail [here](#). You must request your ballot-by-mail no later than October 23, 2020 for the General Election. We recommend that you mail back your ballot by October 27, 2020. You can also take your ballot to any ballot drop box or voting location in your county. **Your ballot must be received by election officials by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 3, 2020.**
- **Vote early in person:** Early voting begins on **October 7** and lines tend to be shorter. Visit your county's [website](#) for a list of Early Voting locations.
- **Vote on Election Day:** Polls will be open from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020. You must be in line by 7:00 p.m. Visit the [Secretary of State's website](#) to learn what identification you should bring with you. You can find your Election Day voting location in advance:

- Rely on trusted sources for election information. In Arizona, your trusted sources are the Secretary of State's Office, County Recorders and Elections Departments, and the Citizens Clean Elections Commission.
- Always consider the source of voting information. Ask yourself: Can I trust this information? Verify with trusted sources that the information you've found is accurate.
